Visitor Arrival Summary


Tourist Arrivals to Jamaica moved from 1.76 million in 2008 to 1.83 million in 2009, an increase of 63.8 thousand or 3.6 percent. This growth was produced by a 2.0 percent increase in the Winter coupled with a 4.5 percent increase in the Summer.

- ♦ The United States continued to be the most significant source market for Jamaica supplying 64.1 percent of arriving tourists, growing by 1.9 percent in 2009. Stopover arrivals from Canada, which continued to show very encouraging growth, surged by 22.9 percent, accounting for a 15.9 percent share of the market, or 290.3 thousand.
- ♦ Unlike Tourist Arrivals, Cruise Passenger arrivals had negative growth owing to the sizeable declines in Winter months, which may have been due to the fact that only 334 ships docked in Jamaica in 2009 versus 398 in 2008. Overall, only 922.3 thousand passengers visited Jamaica, representing a reduction of 15.6 percent over the previous year. This was the first time since 2003 that Cruise Passenger numbers fell below the 1.0 million mark.


Visitor Arrival Summary

An 8.2 percent contraction in Stay Over arrival numbers to Martinique resulted in an aggregate of 441.6 thousand in 2009. Martinique experienced a 4.0 percent decline in Tourist Arrivals owing almost completely to the 9.9 percent decline in arrivals in the Winter. Even though this period accounted for less than 40.0 percent of all arrivals (38.6 percent), the almost zero percent change in the Summer could not cause a gain.

- Almost all the significant source markets suffered losses in 2009. Among them was Europe (83.1 percent of total arrivals) which was 4.6 percent fewer, and the French overseas departments (9.1 percent market share), down by 41.7 percent. The only markets registering growth were Other Caribbean, up by 15.9 percent, and Other Countries, almost doubling in 2009.
- As in 2008, only 112 cruise ships docked in Martinique in 2009, resulting in an aggregate of 69.7 thousand Cruise Passenger arrivals, a loss of 19.9 percent over the 2008 total. Arrivals in the Winter diminished by 32.1 percent, while those in the Summer remained steady with a slight 2.1 percent shrinking.

THE MEXICAN CARIBBEAN (CANCUN, COZUMEL, RIVERA MAYA)


Visitor Arrival Summary

The Mexican Caribbean destinations have emerged in the last decade to be major players in Caribbean tourism. Cancun, Cozumel and now Riviera Maya are resort destinations which rely heavily on the US market and are now extending their share of the European market.

- ♦ Cancun: International tourists (foreign hotel guests) to Cancun in 2009 suffered a 12.6 percent decrease to end at 1.9 million, down from the almost 2.2 million tourists hosted in 2008. The Winter season edged marginally upward by 1.0 percent, whereas the Summer seasons suffered a 21.1 percent reduction. The United States claimed a 79.5 percent market share for a total of 1.5 million tourists, or a loss of 10.5 percent. Europe, with an 8.3 percent market share weakened sharply by 26.1 percent. The Canadian market also experienced a softening as arrivals fell by 5.8 percent to total 122.9 thousand. The combined markets of Central America and the Caribbean grew marginally by 2.4 percent. Arrivals from Japan and the Rest of the World combined were almost halved, falling by 46.2 percent.
- ♦ Cozumel: Overall, Cozumel's Cruise industry shrank as that destination welcomed approximately 2.2 million passengers in 2009, 13.5 percent fewer than in the previous year. The biggest losses came in the Summer (down 16.9 percent), with May (-95.5 percent), June (-43.2 percent), October (13.5 percent) and November (19.1 percent) dropping the most. The Winter period performed somewhat worse than it did in 2008 with a 8.8 percent decline.


Visitor Arrival Summary

Montserrat's tourist industry continued its decline in 2009, sliding by 14.3 percent to a reported total of 6.3 thousand arrivals. The Winter period fell by 12.9 percent and arrivals in the Summer declined by 14.7 percent.

♦ The Caribbean was the main source market for tourist arrivals to Montserrat in 2009, with a total of 2.3 thousand arrivals - 35.9 percent of the total, but a decline of 14.7 percent. The European market continued to perform strongly (32.2 percent market share), even though it likewise supplied fewer Stopover arrivals to the island, some 12.9 percent less. Of the 2.0 thousand Stopovers originating in Europe, 1.9 thousand came from the United Kingdom, representing 29.5 percent of the overall total for the year. The United States, with a 25.4 percent market share, continued to decline, slipping to 1.6 thousand tourists, a loss of 16.4 percent.

PUERTO RICO

Visitor Arrival Summary

Non-resident hotel registrations to Puerto Rico are estimated to have decreased by 1.7 percent in 2009, to end at a total of 1.3 million. Winter arrivals contracted by 7.7 percent while Summer arrivals increased by 2.2 percent.


- ♦ With a 90.2 percentage share of the arrivals market, the United States continued to be the leading source market for Puerto Rico. However, the island hosted slightly fewer tourists than in the previous year some 1,171.4 thousand or 1.2 percent less. All other main markets, with the exception of Canada, were down as well, with the most marked decreases occurring in the Other Countries and Caribbean markets, where respectively 10.1 percent and 7.1 percent less hotel registrations were recorded.
- The 2009 Cruise Passenger arrivals number was under the recorded total for 2008. Only 1,179.0 thousand passengers sailed into port, resulting in negative growth of 18.6 percent or a whopping 213.6 thousand. This may have been attributed to the berthing of only 463 ships, versus the 539 recorded for 2008.


Visitor Arrival Summary

Tourist Arrivals by air to Saba continued to increase, growing from 7.1 thousand to 7.7 thousand in 2009, an 8.7 percent change. On the other hand, Sea Arrivals numbers were down by 14.1, for a total of 4,282. The Winter and Summer seasons showed slight movements in either direction, with the Winter up by 1.4 percent and the Summer down by 2.0 percent.

The main markets show mixed performance in 2008. Increases were recorded in tourist arrivals from Holland/Antilles (12.6%), Canada (24.4%), and France (20.9%). On the other hand, declines were registered in arrivals from the United States (-15.1%), the United Kingdom (-17.8%), and Other Countries (-10.1%).
